How to Enter

Each raffle ticket is \$20. Entry purchasers may purchase as many raffle tickets as they desire. Eligibility

The Raffle is offered in person through individuals representing the Raffle for Full House Motorsports, LLC. All individuals legally residing in the U.S. who are 18 years old or older are eligible to participate in the Raffle. Employees, officers, and directors of Full House Motorsports, LLC; its affiliates; advertising, promotion and legal advisors, and their immediate family members and persons living in the same household, are eligible to participate in the Raffle. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited.

Prize

One (1) custom built 1954 Pontiac Chieftain car (approximate retail value is MSRP US\$115,000). The car shown on the raffle form, on the raffle web page and other raffle related materials is not the actual prize vehicle but represents a likeness of the prize. No alternative prize, cash equivalent, or other substitution is permitted except by Sponsor. All federal, state, and or local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner and must be paid in full at time of prize pick up. Should winner not be able to provide all funds for transfer of title, registration, and applicable taxes, winner will forfeit said prize and ownership will revert back to Full House Motorsports, LLC.

Selection of Winner

Winner will be determined by a random drawing by Full House Motorsports, LLC from the eligible entries. All decisions are final and binding. Odds of winning are determined by the number of tickets sold. The winner will be notified by fax, e-mail, telephone, regular mail, or in person. Full House Motorsports, LLC is not responsible for and shall not be liable for late, lost or misdirected communication, or unsuccessful efforts to notify winner.

Entry purchasers providing the Sponsor with a valid mail address will receive confirmation ticket sent to them via mail. Ticket confirmation number(s) will be sent within ten (10) business days of purchase. A hard copy ticket confirmation number is required to claim a prize.

Winner

The Prize Winner will be notified within seven (7) business days of the drawing via email, phone or mail should they not be present at the drawing on March 25, 2012. The Prize Winner must contact Full House Motorsports, LLC as instructed in the notification and acknowledge/accept being the prize winner within seven (7) business days of the notification.
